


You will need seed raising mix or potting mix with sand/pumice added, trays with lots of drainage holes, seeds! label with name and date, watering can with rose attached or dish for tray to sit in while soaking up water from the bottom, a space with plenty of airflow and good light.





Fill your seed tray to nearly full and evenly press mix down. You can also use another tray same size, pressed down onto mix. This helps reduce settling in the mix when you go to water after sowing.



Fine seed can be sprinkled on top then pressed in gently. Larger seeds need to be pushed into the mix to help anchor them (roughly twice the depth of seed size) if big seeds are still slightly visible sprinkle some mix over top.





Water your babies in by either gently watering with a watering can sprinkled over top, or by adding water to a tray and letting it soak up into the mix. Keep a daily eye on your seeds and make sure mix stays damp but not soaking- I usually water well once a day and let water drain away.
